

How to use this Map

This map shows the majority of rural bus services that operate in Perth and Kinross and is an aid to planning journeys around the area. As well as indicating links to all the settlements in Perth and Kinross, it also shows where the main visitor attractions are.

The bus can be used to access almost every corner of Perth and Kinross and the map will tell you which service is appropriate to the journey you want to make.

The table highlighting service frequencies gives an indication of how often each bus service operates but for full details it will be necessary to refer to one of the Council's five Local Public Transport Guides. These provide timetables for all rural bus services in Perth and Kinross along with other useful public transport information.

Ticketing

Day return tickets are available on most rural bus services and are cheaper than buying two single journey tickets. Ten journey tickets and commuter cards are also available for many services and will offer regular travellers a considerable saving. For availability of Day Rover tickets please contact the relevant bus operator

Public & School Holidays

Traditionally on 25 December and 01 January no local bus services operate. On 26 December and 02 January service levels are often reduced, whilst some operators do not operate any buses. Details on what will operate can be obtained from the relevant bus operator or from the Council's Public Transport Unit.

On other public holidays during the year, the majority of bus services will operate a normal timetable. Any proposed changes should be advertised on the bus, alternatively contact the relevant operator prior to travel.

Schoolday only bus services will only operate during school term times. Perth and Kinross Council schools have the following term dates:

Summer Term – Monday 16 April 2007 to Wednesday 27 June 2007
Autumn Term – Tuesday 14 August 2007 to Friday 28 September 2007
Winter Term – Monday 15 October 2007 to Friday 21 December 2007

There are also a number of single day holidays during the school years.

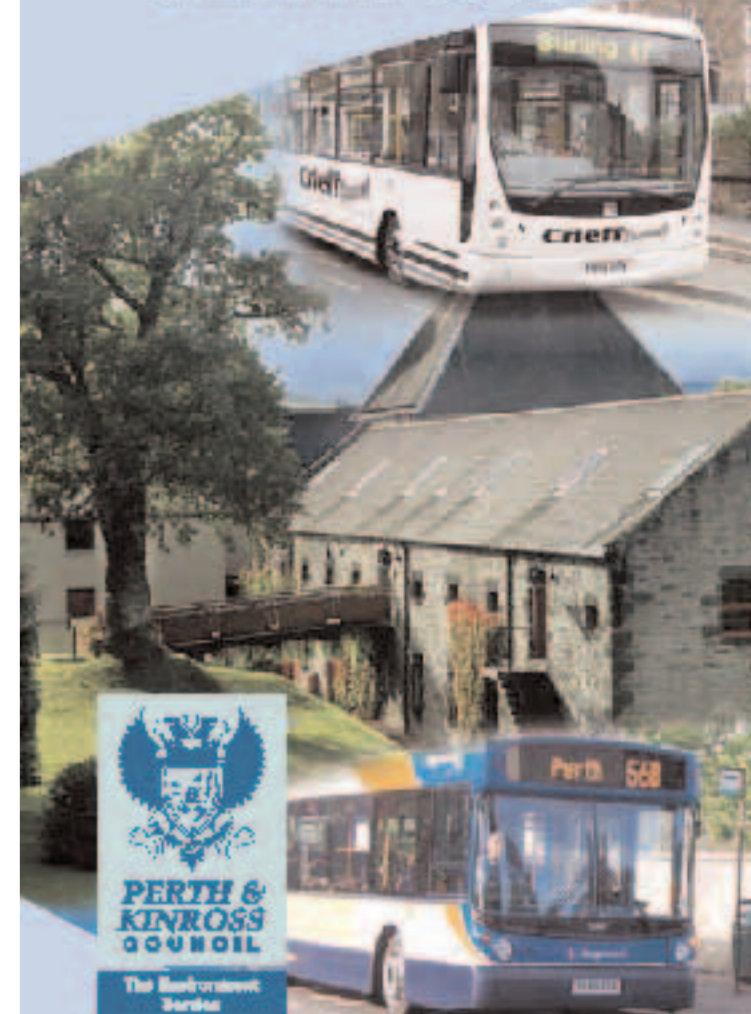

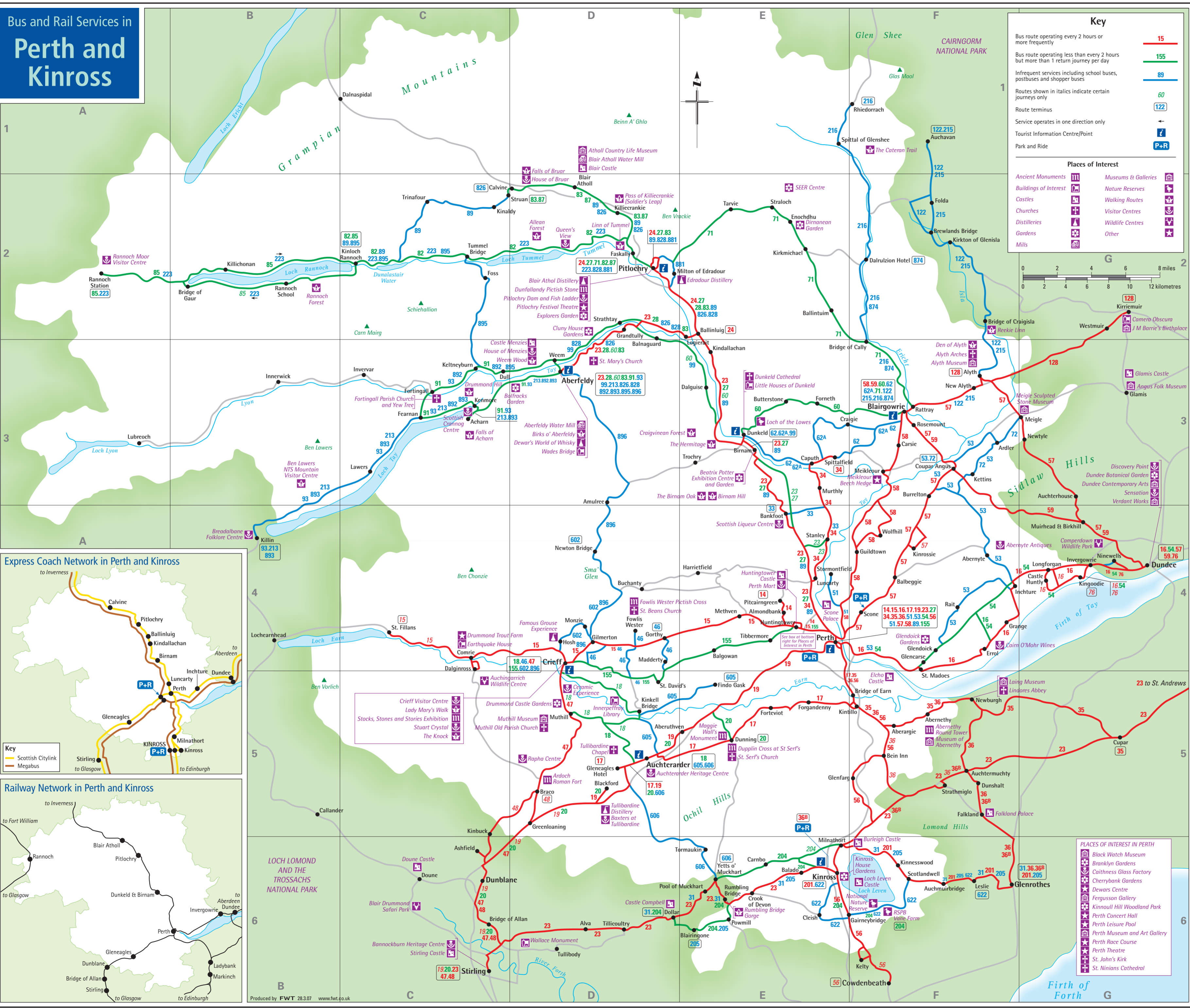


Public Transport Map

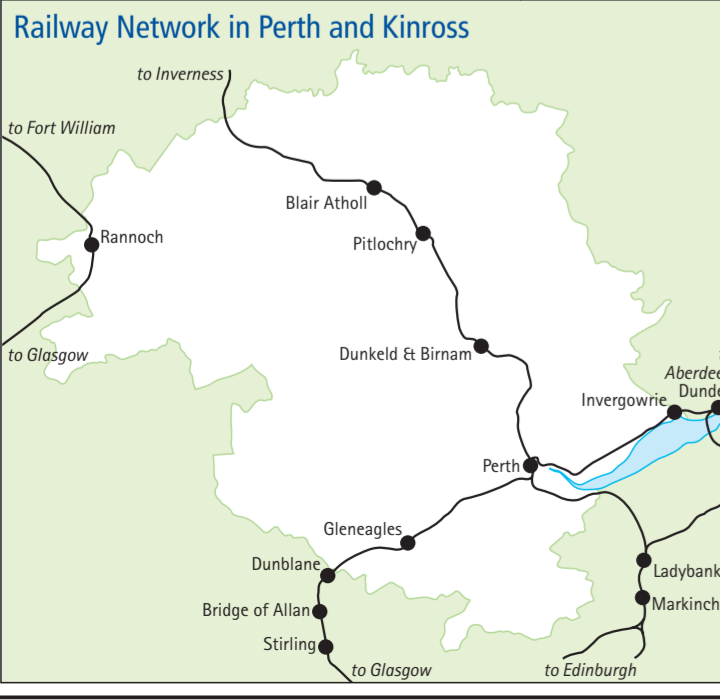
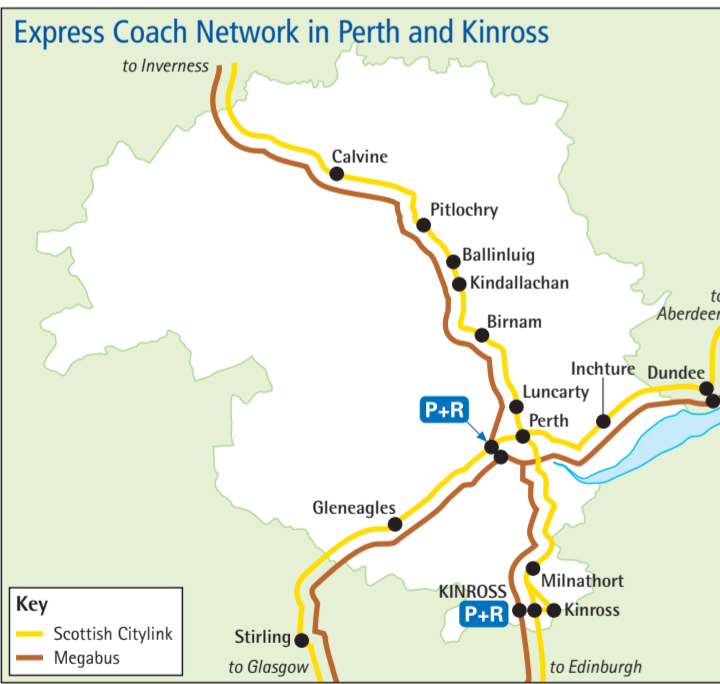
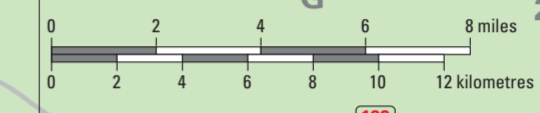
